

### Mnemonics for US Presidents

	1. Washing a 1-ton weight (George Washington) to remember Washington
	2. Adam and Eve (John Adams). Adam and Eve were the first <b>2</b> people.
	3. Jet (Thomas Jefferson). The word 'jet' has <b>3 letters</b> , and Jefferson has <b>3 syllables</b> .
	4. Madison Square in New York (James Madison). A square has <b>4 sides</b> to remember that he is the fourth president.
	5. Marilyn Monroe's Star (James Monroe). A star has <b>5 points</b> to remember that he is the fifth president.
	6. Queen See Adam (John Quincy Adams). The letter Q looks like the <b>number 6</b> .
	7. Michael Jackson (Andrew Jackson). Michael <b>Jackson</b> leans forward like the number '7' when he dances. The word 'Jackson' has 7 letters.
	8. Bureau with 8 drawers (Martin Van Buren). The name 'Van Buren' has 8 letters.
	9. Hairy Son (William Harrison). Imagine a hairy son searching through the bureau.
	10. A Tiler laying <b>10 tiles</b> (John Tyler).
	11. 2 sticks (James Knox Polk). The 2 sticks look like the number '11' and can be used to <b>poke</b> .
	12. A Tailor sewing 12 buttons (Zachary Taylor). Remember 'Tiler poked Tailor' to remember the 3 presidents in order.
	13. Fill More (Millard Fillmore). He wanted to <b>fill more</b> than a dozen cups, i.e. 13 cups.
	14. Pierce (Franklin Pierce). The digit 4 <b>pierced</b> through the digit 1.
	15. Cannon (James Buchanan). The cannon forms the number '15'.
	16. Log Cabin made from <b>16 logs</b> (Abraham Lincoln). Lincoln was born in a log cabin.
	17. Johnson (Andrew Johnson). Both famous assassinated presidents, Lincoln and Kennedy, were succeeded by men named Johnson. The word 'Johnson' has <b>7 letters</b> .
	18. Grant (Ulysses Grant). 18-year olds are <b>granted</b> the rights to vote and drive.
	19. Hay (Rutherford Hayes). Imagine the pitchfork and <b>hay</b> looking like the number '19'.
	20. Garfield the Cat (James Garfield). Imagine Garfield the cat weighing 20 kilograms.
	21. King Arthur (Chester Arthur). Imagine <b>King Arthur</b> forming the number '2' and the sword Excalibur forming the number '1'.
	22. Cleaver (Stephen Grover Cleveland). A <b>cleaver</b> cuts things into 2 halves, to remember 22.
	23. Hairy Son between 2 Cleavers (Benjamin Harrison)
	24. Cleaver (Stephen Grover Cleveland). Using a <b>cleaver 2</b> times will cut things into quarters, to remember 24.

	25. Mountaineer on Mt McKinley (William McKinley). Imagine that he is a quarter-century old, i.e. <b>25 years old</b> .
	26. Teddy Bear with a Letter of the Alphabet (Theodore Roosevelt). There are <b>26 letters</b> in the alphabet.
<b>T aft</b>	27. T aft (William Taft). He came ' <b>aft</b> 'er ' <b>T</b> ' (Teddy Roosevelt).
	28. Mahjong 8 bamboos (Thomas Woodrow Wilson). The <b>8</b> bamboos Mahjong tile looks like the <b>2 W</b> 's in 'Woodrow Wilson' and 'World War I'.
	29. (Warren Harding). You have to be <b>hardy</b> to survive the Depression of '29.
<b>COO</b>	30. (John Calvin Coolidge). The letters ' <b>COO</b> ' look like 3 ' <b>0</b> ', to remember 30.
	31. (Herbert Hoover). During the Depression, people live in shanty towns called ' <b>Hooverville</b> '.
	32. (Franklin D Roosevelt). FDR ' <b>rose</b> ' to the occasion to lead the U.S through the Depression and World War II.
	33. (Harry Truman). The words ' <b>tru</b> ' and ' <b>man</b> ' has <b>3 letters each</b> .
	34. I Like Ike (Dwight Eisenhower). The word ' <b>Ike</b> ' has 3 letters and the word ' <b>like</b> ' has 4 letters.
	35. JFK Candy (John F Kennedy). ' <b>John F</b> ' has 5 letters and ' <b>Kennedy</b> ' has 7 letters. $5 \times 7 = 35$ .
	36. (Lyndon B Johnson). Both famous assassinated presidents, Lincoln and Kennedy, were succeeded by men named Johnson.
	37. Next On (Richard Nixon). Nixon resigned and said ' <b>Next!</b> '.
	38. Fort (Gerald Ford). After Nixon resigned, Ford has to <b>hold the 'fort'</b> .
<b>39</b>	39. Peanut Farmer (Jimmy Carter). Imagine <b>peanuts</b> curved like the number ' <b>39</b> '.
	40. Berlin Wall (Ronald Reagan). Ronald Reagan asked Gorbachev to tear down the Berlin Wall. The Berlin Wall surrounded West Berlin on 4 sides like a ' <b>0</b> '.
	41. B.U.S.H. (George Bush). He joined the navy after Japan attacked Pearl Harbour in <b>1941</b> . The U.S. invaded Iraq to ' <b>Beat Up Saddam Hussein</b> '.
	42. Clinton hiding between 2 Bushes (Bill Clinton).
	43. B.U.S.H. (George W Bush). He finished his father's job to ' <b>Beat Up Saddam Hussein</b> '.
	44. (Barack Obama). He studied for <b>4 years</b> in Indonesia to remember that he is the 44th President.
	45 and 47. (Donald Trump). The word Trump has <b>5 letters</b> to remember that he is the 45th President.
	46. Joe Biden. The word Joseph has <b>6 letters</b> to remember that he is the 46th President.
